



## Ince Internship Programme

The UK law firm, Ince, is offering a four (4) to six (6) months internship programme at any of its international offices, to be awarded to a suitable South African candidate who has undergone the MLA selection process. The internship programme is not an employment opportunity. It is intended to be a transformational experience aimed at providing a deserving candidate with a learning experience of working in another jurisdiction.

### Internship programme details

1. The period of the internship programme will be for a maximum period of six months.
2. The successful candidate will be placed at one of Ince's international offices (i.e. London, Beijing, Gibraltar, Hamburg, Hong Kong, Limassol, Dubai, Singapore, Piraeus or Shanghai).
3. Flights, accommodation and stipend (to cover living expenses) to be paid by Ince.

### Eligibility criteria

1. The candidate must currently be employed as a professional assistant in a law firm or practising as an advocate (i.e. legal practitioners (attorneys and advocates) registered with the Legal Practice Council of South Africa) and have been practising as such for at least one year.
2. The candidate must also be 35 years of age or younger.
3. Preference will be given to candidates from previously disadvantaged groups.
4. The candidate should be someone practising maritime law or with an interest in maritime law. Through this programme, the candidate may obtain exposure to other disciplines within Ince's service offering.
5. The candidate must be in possession of a valid passport.

### Application procedure

1. Candidates will be required to submit a curriculum vitae as well as a motivational letter by Friday **10 September 2021**.
2. Candidates are to ensure that their motivational letter includes their full names, gender, age, full background (educational and professional), what makes them unique and suitable for this programme, their work experience and why it is relevant, and the reason for applying for this internship programme.
